OCCUPANCY PERMITS

All residents are required to have an occupancy permit. If you have moved into a house and did not come to city hall to receive your occupancy permit, you need to come to city hall and fill out the permit. The one-time cost is \$20.

VEHICLE TAGS

Vehicle tags are being distributed at City Hall, please come by to pick up your tags. There is no charge for the tags.

BURNING

St. Louis County has a new law (Rule 10 CSR 10-6.045 that was effective in March 2019. There is no open burning.
